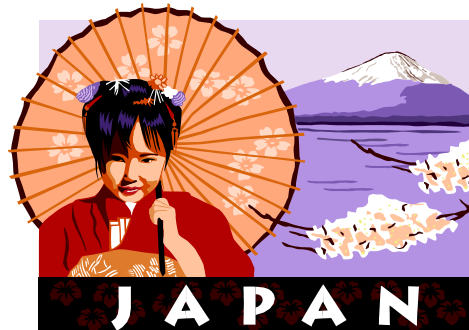

Very important Gala planning meetings are scheduled for September 8th and 22nd. It's getting close to the event, so everyone who can is welcomed to join.

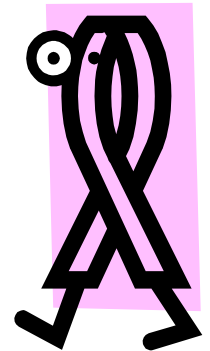
